Science - Calling all **4 and 5 year old** scientists! During this session we will be exploring the 5 Senses, Ice, and Colors.. This class will include experimentation, science related literature, as well as suggestions for having fun with science at home. Students will need to **pack a lunch.**

Math- This class is offered to **4 and 5 year old students**. The hands on activities will be theme based and focus on connecting early math skills to real life situations. The exciting themes will provide children opportunities to develop problem solving skills and think mathematically while making math meaningful and fun! Activities are designed to help teach national math standards in a developmentally appropriate way for young learners. The students enrolled in this class need to **pack a lunch.**
